9 An Act relating to probate procedure; amending 58
10 O.S. 2011, Section 941, which relates to presumption
11 of death; modifying presumption of death
12 requirements; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 58 O.S. 2011, Section 941, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 941. Presumption of death - Any person missing from his
18 usual place of residence and whose address is unknown by his or her
19 family or those who, in the ordinary course of events, would be
20 expected to know his whereabouts, who is continuously absent ~~and,~~
21 unheard of for a period of ~~seven (7)~~ two (2) years or longer and
22 entered into the National Missing and Unidentified Persons System
23 with all identifiers, including dental records, fingerprints and
24 DNA, for a minimum of six (6) months prior to declaration of death,

1 shall be presumed to be dead and the district court, after the
2 expiration of such period, shall have jurisdiction and authority to
3 declare such person to be legally dead and to issue letters
4 testamentary or letters of administration upon the estates of such
5 persons.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
