PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services; providing for reappropriation and redesignation of certain funds in certain amount for a certain purpose; authorizing certain expenditures of certain funds; providing amounts; providing purposes; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION AND REDESIGNATION The amount of Two Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,600,000.00) of the original appropriation of Five Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,600,000.00), appropriated to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services by Section 132, Chapter 146, O.S.L. 2018, from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury to reconcile costs associated with the funding of

1 state pension systems, is hereby reappropriated and redesignated to  
2 the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to perform duties  
3 imposed upon the Office by law. If, on the date this act is  
4 approved, any of the amount originally appropriated, as adjusted by  
5 expenditures, encumbrances and transfers, results in an unencumbered  
6 balance less than the reappropriated and redesignated amount, that  
7 reappropriated and redesignated amount is reduced to the  
8 unencumbered amount.

9 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
10 Office of Management and Enterprise Services is hereby authorized to  
11 expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, from the Postal  
12 Service Revolving Fund (Fund 231), the sum of One Hundred Fifty  
13 Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) or so much thereof as may be  
14 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of  
15 Management and Enterprise Services by law.

16 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
17 Office of Management and Enterprise Services is hereby authorized to  
18 expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, from the  
19 Registration of State Vendors Revolving Fund (Fund 270), the sum of  
20 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) or so much thereof as may be  
21 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of  
22 Management and Enterprise Services by law.

23 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
24 Office of Management and Enterprise Services is hereby authorized to

1 expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, from the Vendor  
2 Fees and Rebates Revolving Fund (Fund 271), the sum of One Million  
3 Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$1,250,000.00) or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the  
5 Office of Management and Enterprise Services by law.

6 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
