PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Constitutional Reserve Fund;  
identifying declaration of emergency conditions;  
making an appropriation; stating amount; stating  
purpose; providing for noncodification; and declaring  
an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

In accordance with the Governor's declaration of emergency by  
Executive Order 2020-12, and pursuant to paragraph 8 of Section 23  
of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby  
appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State  
Treasury the sum of Two Hundred One Million Five Hundred Fifty-nine

1 Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-four Dollars (\$201,559,654.00) to the  
2 Revenue Stabilization Fund created pursuant to Section 34.102 of  
3 Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, to be utilized as provided by  
4 law.

5 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
6 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
