L5	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified				
L 6	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-103H of Title 47, unless				
L7	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:				
L8	A. This section shall be known and may be cited as "Hunter's				
9	Safe Freight Act".				
20	B. As used in this section "side underride guard" means a				
21	device installed on or near the side of a trailer or semitrailer				
22	that prevents or limits the probability that a vehicle will slide				
23	under the side of the trailer or semitrailer in a side-impact crash				
24	or a bicycle or pedestrian will intrude the space underneath the				

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- 1 trailer in front of the rear wheels in the event of a collision or 2 fall.
  - C. No later than January 1, 2022, all trailers or semitrailers manufactured, sold or registered in this state shall be equipped with side underride guards that meet the performance standards described in subsection D of this section if:
- 7 1. The trailer has a gross vehicle weight rating of ten 8 thousand (10,000) pounds or more; or

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- 2. The semitrailer has a gross vehicle weight rating of ten thousand (10,000) pounds or more.
- D. A side underride guard shall be considered to meet the performance standards required by this section if:
- 1. The side underride guard is able to prevent intrusion from the body or frame of a vehicle into the passenger compartment of a passenger motor vehicle that contacts the guard while traveling thirty-five (35) miles per hour at any angle between ten (10) degrees and ninety (90) degrees;
- 2. The side underride guard achieves a smooth and continuous longitudinal impact surface;
- 3. The lowest edge of the side underride guard is a maximum of twenty-two (22) inches above the ground;
- 4. The upper edge of the side underride guard is a maximum of fourteen inches below the structure of the vehicle;

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- 5. The side underride guard does not increase the width of the vehicle;
- 6. The side underride guard is less than five (5) inches inboard of the maximum width of the vehicle; and
- 7. The side underride guard is not more than twelve (12) inches from the outer part of the tires immediately fore and aft of the guard.
- E. This section shall not apply to trailers or semitrailers that are low enough profile to prevent the intrusion from the body or frame of a vehicle into the passenger compartment of a passenger motor vehicle that contacts the side of the trailer or semitrailer while travelling thirty-five (35) miles per hour at any angle between ten (10) degrees and ninety (90) degrees.
- F. The Department of Public Safety may promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.

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
