The inmate shall be entitled to have a staff representative appointed to represent him or her the inmate, if he or she so requests, but shall not have an attorney appointed or paid by the Department to represent him or her the inmate at the administrative hearing; and

- 2. Once an inmate has been assigned to a unit described in this subsection, treatment and medication may be administered to the inmate as provided in Section 5-204 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- B. The Carl Albert Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services

 Center shall provide to the Department of Corrections a psychiatrist

 as needed to assist in a unit described in subsection A of this

 section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
