- 3. Certificates issued pursuant to a program offered by an approved provider under Section 6-133 of this title;
- 4. Certificates issued to those with valid out-of-state and out-of-country certification pursuant to Section 6-190 of this title; and
- 5. Any other alternative or nontraditional pathway to teacher certification approved by the State Board of Education, which shall include a breakdown of each certification pathway.

In addition, the report shall include the following information for those receiving emergency certifications:

- The total number of emergency certificates requested, approved, issued and used in the state;
 - 2. The number of emergency certified teachers per district;
 - 3. The number of emergency certified teachers by subject area;
- 4. The number of those who held a standard teaching certificate prior to receiving the emergency certificate; and
- 5. The number of emergency certifications which are renewed for a second year.
 - The report shall be made available by October 1 of each year on the Department's website.
