8 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to telephone services; enacting the  
10 Telephone Landline Presentation Act of 2020; allowing  
11 persons or business entities to maintain existing  
12 telephone services; providing for imposition of  
13 charges or fees by service providers; providing for  
14 codification; providing for noncodification; and  
15 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
18 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

19 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Telephone  
20 Landline Preservation Act of 2020".

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 139.201 of Title 17, unless  
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 Any person or business entity that has wired telephone service  
through any local exchange carrier or interexchange carrier as of

1 the effective date of this act shall have the right to maintain such  
2 wired telephone service subject to such charges or fees as may be  
3 imposed for maintaining such service by the carrier.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
