PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to counties and county officers;
amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 377, which relates to
data processing technicians; authorizing county to
employ information technology staff; updating
references; eliminating technician employment term
cap; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 377, is
amended to read as follows:

Section 377. The board of county commissioners of any county
may employ a competent information technology (IT) staff and a data
processing technician, who shall perform the duties of IT management
or data processing management as prescribed and directed by the
board of county commissioners,~~and such data processing technician~~
~~shall not be employed beyond the term of office of the board of~~
~~county commissioners employing him.~~ The said IT staff and data
processing technician shall receive as compensation a salary
salaries to be fixed by the board of county commissioners for his

1 their services, to be paid out of the general operating fund of the
2 county. The compensations of the ~~director and such personnel~~ IT
3 staff and data processing technician shall not be governed by the
4 "Comprehensive Salary Code".

5 The IT staff and data processing technician shall be covered by
6 the county blanket bond.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
