SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1442 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

As used in the Home Bakery Act of 2013:

- 1. "Home food establishment" shall mean a business on the premises of a residence in which prepared food is created for sale or resale at farmers markets, on site, at cooperatives, through membership-based buying clubs or for delivery, if the business has gross annual sales of prepared food of less than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00). Gross annual sales includes all sales of prepared food produced by the business at any location; and
- 2. "Prepared food" shall mean foods that have been produced, processed or packaged that are not potentially hazardous and do not require refrigeration. These foods include pickled fruits and vegetables, salsa, spices, teas, dehydrated produce, nuts, seeds, jams, jellies, preserves, fruit butter, flour, candy, sauces and baked goods, including tortillas. Prepared food shall not include any product that contains meat.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1443 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. A home food establishment may sell prepared food on site, by delivery, at a farmers market, through a cooperative, or through a membership-based buying club.

- B. A home food establishment shall be exempt from the licensing
