- B. The sheriff has the responsibility and authority for selecting the security plans and administration of the plans for counties.
- C. The contracts may be for a period not to exceed a time as determined by the commissioners subject to annual appropriations by the county excise board.
- D. Security guard agencies or security guards providing security for buildings shall be licensed pursuant to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator Act permitting the holder to perform the functions of a security guard, armed security guard or security agency.
