PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to open records; amending 51 O.S. 2011, Section 24A.16, which relates to educational records; allowing educational institutions to designate information as directory information; requiring written consent of local school board and primary custodian of student directory information prior to release by educational agencies or institutions; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 51 O.S. 2011, Section 24A.16, is amended to read as follows:

Section 24A.16 A. Except as set forth in subsection B of this section, public educational institutions and their employees may keep confidential:

1. Individual student records;
2. Teacher lesson plans, tests and other teaching material; and
3. Personal communications concerning individual students.

1 B. If kept, statistical information not identified with a
2 particular student and directory information shall be open for
3 inspection and copying. ~~"Directory"~~ Each educational institution may
4 choose to designate specific information which shall be classified
5 as directory information for students attending the educational
6 institution. In accordance with the Federal Educational Rights and
7 Privacy Act, Section 1232g of Title 20 of the United States Code,
8 "directory information" includes a student's name, address,
9 telephone listing, date and place of birth, major field of study,
10 participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight
11 and height of members of athletic teams, dates of attendance,
12 degrees and awards received, and the most recent previous
13 educational institution attended by the student. Any educational
14 agency or institution making public directory information shall give
15 public notice of the categories of information which it has
16 designated as directory information with respect to each student
17 attending the institution or agency and shall allow a reasonable
18 period of time after the notice has been given for a parent to
19 inform the institution or agency that any or all of the information
20 designated should not be released without prior consent of the
21 parent or guardian or the student if the student is eighteen (18)
22 years of age or older.

23 C. All educational agencies or institutions, including the
24 State Department of Education, which are not the primary custodians

1 of student directory information of students attending the
2 educational institution but are allowed to access the information
3 for educational purposes, shall be prohibited from releasing or
4 selling any or all student directory information without the written
5 consent of the local school board and primary custodian of student
6 directory information designated and collected by the local
7 educational institution.

8 D. A public school district may release individual student
9 records for the current or previous school year to a school district
10 at which the student was previously enrolled for purposes of
11 evaluating educational programs and school effectiveness.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
