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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:							
20	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 51 O.S. 2011, Section 24A.16, is							
21	amended to read as follows:							
22	Section 24A.16 A. Except as set forth in subsection B of this							
23	section, public educational institutions and their employees may							
24	keep confidential:							

1. Individual student records;

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- 2. Teacher lesson plans, tests and other teaching material; and
- 3. Personal communications concerning individual students.
- If kept, statistical information not identified with a В. 5 particular student and directory information shall be open for inspection and copying. "Directory Except as provided in subsection 6 7 D of this section, each educational institution may choose to designate specific information which shall be classified as 8 9 directory information for students attending the educational 10 institution. In accordance with the Family Educational Rights and 11 Privacy Act, Section 1232g of Title 20 of the United States Code and 12 Part 99 of Title 34 of the Code of Federal Regulations, "directory 13 information" includes a student's name, address, telephone listing, 14 date and place of birth, major field of study, participation in 15 officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of 16 members of athletic teams, dates of attendance, degrees and awards 17 received, and the most recent previous educational institution 18 attended by the student. Any educational agency or institution 19 making public directory information shall give public notice of the 20 categories of information which it has designated as directory 21 information with respect to each student attending the institution 22 or agency and shall allow a reasonable period of time after the 23 notice has been given for a parent to inform the institution or 24 agency that any or all of the information designated should not be

released without prior consent of the parent or guardian or the student if the student is eighteen (18) years of age or older.

- C. Except as provided in subsection D of this section, all educational agencies or institutions which are not the primary custodians of student directory information of students attending the educational institution, but are allowed to access the information for educational purposes, shall be prohibited from releasing or selling any or all student directory information without the written consent of the local school board and primary custodian of student directory information designated and collected by the local educational institution.
- D. The State Department of Education and the State Board of
 Education shall not classify any personally identifiable student
 information as directory information, as defined in subsection B of
 this section, and shall keep personally identifiable student
 information confidential unless disclosure is authorized by the
 Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, Section 1232g of Title 20
 of the United States Code and Part 99 of Title 34 of the Code of
 Federal Regulations.
- E. A public school district may release individual student records for the current or previous school year to a school district at which the student was previously enrolled for purposes of evaluating educational programs and school effectiveness.
