PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to insurance; amending Section 1, Chapter 74, O.S.L. 2015 (36 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 6060.9b), which relates to proton therapy; requiring proton therapy to be deemed as medically necessary based on patient's provider's medical judgment; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 74, O.S.L. 2015 (36 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 6060.9b), is amended to read as follows:

Section 6060.9b A. A health benefit plan, as defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of ~~Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title, that provides coverage for cancer therapy shall be prohibited from holding proton radiation therapy to a higher standard of clinical evidence for medical policy benefit coverage decisions than the health plan requires for coverage of any other

1 radiation therapy treatment. Proton therapy shall be deemed
2 medically necessary based upon the patient's provider's medical
3 judgment.

4 B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to mandate the
5 coverage of proton radiation therapy by a health benefit plan.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.

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
