PROPOSED SUBCOMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2011, Section 6-206.1, as amended by Section 603, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (70 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 6-206.1), which relates to the Oklahoma School Psychologist, Speech-Language Pathologist, and Audiologist National Certification Revolving Fund; renaming fund; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 6-206.1, as amended by Section 603, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (70 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 6-206.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-206.1 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the State Board of Education to be designated the "Oklahoma School Psychologist, Speech-Language Pathologist, and Audiologist ~~National~~ Board Certification ~~Revolving~~ Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,

1 and shall consist of all monies appropriated or transferred to the  
2 fund by the Legislature. All monies accruing to the credit of the  
3 fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the  
4 State Board of Education to provide an annual bonus for individuals  
5 meeting the requirements of Section 6-206 of this title.

6 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the  
7 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the  
8 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for  
9 approval and payment.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
12 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
