14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified			
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 334 of Title 61, unless there is			
16	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:			
17	A. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall			
18	display the national motto of the United States in a prominently			
19	visible location in all state buildings. The placement and size of			
20	the display shall be in keeping with the placement and size of the			
21	display of the national motto in the United States Capitol Visitor			
22	Center. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall be

In the event that the legality or constitutionality of the display is challenged in a court of law, the Oklahoma Attorney General is hereby authorized to prepare and present a legal defense of the display. C. The display of the national motto shall not be construed to mean that the State of Oklahoma favors any particular religion or denomination thereof over others. SECTION 2.
