17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified					
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-3-110 of Title 27A, unless					
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:					
20	A. The Department of Environmental Quality Executive Director					
21	shall submit an application to the Long-Range Capital Planning					
22	Commission for the sale of the Department's headquarters building					
23	and connected appurtenances located at 707 N. Robinson in downtown					
24	Oklahoma City. The Commissioners of the Land Office shall be					

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   responsible for the sale of the building. The funds from the sale

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The Commissioners of the Land Office shall coordinate with the Department Executive Director to find suitable retrofitted existing office space, or, if suitable accommodations are not available, build a new facility for the Department in which to relocate the Department.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
