9 An Act relating to Department of Environmental
10 Quality; directing submission of certain application;
11 directing sale of certain building and appurtenances;
12 making the Commissioners of the Land Office
13 responsible for certain sale; directing the deposit
14 of funds; allowing for certain determination;
15 providing for agency personnel relocation; providing
16 for codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-3-110 of Title 27A, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. The Department of Environmental Quality Executive Director
22 shall submit an application to the Long-Range Capital Planning
23 Commission for the sale of the Department's headquarters building
24 and connected appurtenances located at 707 N. Robinson in downtown
Oklahoma City. The Commissioners of the Land Office shall be

1 responsible for the sale of the building. The funds from the sale
2 of the building shall be deposited in the Commissioners of the Land
3 Office Revolving Fund as created pursuant to Section 1011 of Title
4 64 of the Oklahoma Statutes. However, the sale of the building
5 shall not proceed if the Commissioners of the Land Office determine
6 the proceeds offered for the building are not financially
7 sufficient.

8 B. The Commissioners of the Land Office shall coordinate with
9 the Department Executive Director to find suitable retrofitted
10 existing office space, or, if suitable accommodations are not
11 available, build a new facility for the Department in which to
12 relocate the Department.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
