COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;  
creating a revolving fund; providing that the fund  
shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations;  
describing sources of funding; directing the Director  
of the Department of Human Services to provide a  
monthly report to the Senate Appropriations Chair and  
the House Appropriations and Budget Chair; stating  
contents of the report; providing that all monies  
accruing to the credit of the fund are appropriated  
and shall be budgeted and expended by the Departments  
only at the direction of the Legislature; stating  
allowable uses for the fund; requiring certain  
procedures for expenditures from the fund; providing  
for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 229.1 of Title 56, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1       There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
2 for the Department of Human Services to be designated the  
3 "Department of Human Services Infrastructure Revolving Fund". The  
4 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year  
5 limitations, and shall consist of all monies designated to the fund  
6 by law. The Director of the Department of Human Services shall, at  
7 the end of each month, provide a current balance and statement of  
8 encumbrances of the fund to the Chair of the Appropriations  
9 Committee of the Senate and the Chair of the Committee on  
10 Appropriations and Budget of the House of Representatives. All  
11 monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated  
12 and shall only be budgeted and expended at the direction of the  
13 Oklahoma Legislature. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon  
14 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as  
15 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and  
16 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

17       SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
