8 An Act relating to memorial highway and bridge  
9 designations; designating the Trooper J.C. Magar  
10 Memorial Highway; designating the Edward A. DeVore,  
11 Jr., Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient, Memorial  
12 Bridge; designating the CPL Russell Keck, Navy Star  
13 Recipient, Memorial Highway; requiring certain  
14 markers; providing for codification; and providing an  
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless  
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The portion of State Highway 271 beginning south of the  
21 municipal limits of Hugo and ending north of the municipal limits of  
22 Grant shall be designated as the "Trooper J.C. Magar Memorial  
23 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
24 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

1       SECTION 2.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless  
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4       The bridge over Coal Creek located on US Highway 75 Business  
5 within the municipal limits of Henryetta shall be designated as the  
6 "Edward A. DeVore, Jr., Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient,  
7 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
8 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the  
9 bridge.

10       SECTION 3.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless  
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13       The portion of State Highway 56 beginning just west of North  
14 Wood Drive and extending approximately one (1) mile west through the  
15 municipal limits of Okmulgee shall be designated as the "CPL Russell  
16 Keck, Navy Star Recipient, Memorial Highway". The Department of  
17 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that  
18 name to be placed on the highway.

19       SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
