10	organizations; subjecting certain organization to the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act; and providing an
11	effective date.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 272, O.S.L.
16	2019 (70 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 5-200), is amended to read as
17	follows:
18	Section 5-200. A. As used in this section, "educational
19	management organization" means a for-profit or nonprofit
20	organization that receives public funds to provide administration
21	and management services for a charter school, statewide virtual
22	charter school or traditional public school.
23	B. A charter school that contracts with an educational
24	management organization shall use the Oklahoma Cost Accounting

1 System (OCAS) to report the total amount paid to an educational 2 management organization as well as itemized expenditure information 3 for the goods or services provided by the management organization as 4 defined by OCAS expenditure codes, including the total compensation 5 package of the superintendent including the base salary, insurance, 6 retirement and other fringe benefits.

C. Any owner of an educational management organization shall be required to disclose to the governing board of the school in a public meeting any ownership position in any business that contracts or proposes to contract with the same public school that the educational management organization is managing.

12 D. Whenever any person shall enter into a contract with any school district or public charter school in the state to teach in 13 such school district or public charter school the contract shall be 14 binding on the teacher and on the board of education until the 15 teacher legally has been discharged from the teaching position or 16 released by the board of education from the contract. Except as 17 provided in Section 5-106A of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this 18 title, until such teacher has been thus discharged or released, the 19 teacher shall not have authority to enter into a contract with any 20 other board of education in Oklahoma the state for the same time 21 covered by the original contract. If upon written complaint by the 22 board of education in a district any teacher is reported to have 23 failed to obey the terms of the contract previously made and to have 24

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1	entered into a contract with another board of education, including a
2	public charter school board of education, without having been
3	released from the former contract except as provided in Section 5-
4	106A of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title, the teacher,
5	upon being found to be employed full-time for another public school,
6	including a public charter school in the state, at a hearing held
7	before the State Board of Education, shall have such teacher's
8	certificate suspended for the remainder of the term for which the
9	contract was made.
10	E. Educational management organizations shall be subject to the
11	provisions of the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
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
