Supp. 2019, Section 954), which relate to maximum contributions, contribution limits, payment of 10 certain employer contributions from court funds, and employees whose salaries are paid from the Law 11 Library Fund; authorizing a one-time lump sum 12 contribution in certain circumstances; modifying amount county and court fund may pay into county retirement system; modifying certain credit for 13 employment of drainage district employees; modifying limit of certain total contributions; deleting 14 obsolete language; updating statutory language; 15 providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency. 16 17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 18 SECTION 1. 19 O.S. 2011, Section 954, as 19 AMENDATORY amended by Section 1, Chapter 380, O.S.L. 2019 (19 O.S. Supp. 2019, 20 Section 954), is amended to read as follows: 21 Section 954. It shall be the mandatory duty of the board of 22 county commissioners of any county establishing a retirement fund 23 and system to appropriate annually, for the sole use of the 24

The governing body of the participating employers listed in this section may vary the percentage contribution of the employer and employee, provided the total percentage contributed by the employer and employee equals the total percentage contribution required by this section. Payment of such shall be paid to the fund upon verified claims by the treasurer of the fund approved by the board of trustees and attested by its clerk. For any contribution made on or after July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2020, of less than eighteen and one-half percent (18.5%), an employer may retroactively make a one-time lump sum contribution of
