8 An Act relating to narcotic treatment programs;
9 amending 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-603, which relates
10 to medication fee for participation in opioid
11 substitution treatment program; granting certain
12 opioid substitution treatment programs authority to
13 assess medication fee; and providing an effective
14 date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-603, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 3-603. A. The Board of Mental Health and Substance
19 Abuse Services shall approve a standard medication fee for persons
20 participating in an opioid substitution treatment program which
21 accepts Medicare or Medicaid. An opioid substitution treatment
22 program which does not accept either Medicare or Medicaid may assess
23 a medication fee on persons participating in the opioid substitution
24 treatment program in an amount determined by the opioid substitution
treatment program.

1 B. A person participating in an opioid substitution treatment
2 program shall be terminated from the program if the person fails to
3 participate in counseling sessions or if the person fails to adhere
4 to the program's guidelines as promulgated by the Board.

5 C. The Board is authorized to promulgate such rules as are
6 necessary to implement this act.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
