NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-169 of Title 70, unless there 20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 21 The State Board of Education shall issue a request for 22 proposals on or before December 31, 2019, for the selection of a 23

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statewide student information system.

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- B. The Board shall adopt a statewide student information system from the selected proposals that were submitted pursuant to subsection A of this section.
- C. The statewide student information system selected pursuant to this section shall be administered on a pilot program basis for two (2) years. The Board shall develop a structure to incentivize school districts to participate in the pilot program; however, participation shall not be required. As part of the pilot program, the Board shall study, develop and establish policies for data inventory and data elements including the definition of data fields for the student information system.
- D. Based on the success of the pilot program, the Board may implement the student information system on a statewide basis, at which time participation shall be required for all school districts in the state. The Board may establish a fee for school district participation in the statewide student information system.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
