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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5031 of Title 63, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall directly administer
19	all outpatient pharmacy benefits for all Medicaid recipients. The
20	Authority shall establish an outpatient pharmacy benefits program
21	that includes:
22	1. A formulary;
23	2. Reimbursement methodologies; and

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- 3. A dispensing fee which shall take into account applicable guidance by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.
- B. Pharmacy claims for all recipients of managed care shall be carved-out on any managed care contract and any request for proposal and shall be delivered through the existing Medicaid structure.

 Existing pharmacy program clinical editing parameters and formulary criteria shall apply for coverage of pharmacy claims.
- C. The Authority may contract with a third-party pharmacy benefit administrator consultant to support the Authority in its administration of pharmacy benefits to Medicaid recipients.
- D. The Authority shall seek any necessary federal approval to implement the provisions of this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.
 - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
