8	An Act relating to the State Fire Marshal; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Sections 324.1, as amended by Section
9	1, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 2012, 324.2, as amended by Section 17, Chapter 111, O.S.L. 2013 and 324.4 (74
10	O.S. Supp. 2018, Sections 324.1 and 324.2), which relate to the State Fire Marshal Commission;
11	modifying appointment of members of the Commission; authorizing Governor to appoint State Fire Marshal;
12	and declaring an emergency.
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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 324.1, as
18	amended by Section 1, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2018,
19	Section 324.1), is amended to read as follows:
20	Section 324.1 There is hereby re-created the State Fire Marshal
21	Commission, which shall consist of seven (7) the following nine (9)
22	members appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall appoint
23	initially one member who shall serve for a term of five (5) years,
24	one member from a statewide association of career and volunteer

1	firefighters who shall serve for a term of four (4) years, one
2	member from a statewide association of municipalities who shall
3	serve for a term of three (3) years, one member from a statewide
4	association of Fire Chiefs, both career and volunteer, who shall
5	serve for a term of two (2) years, one member who shall be a Fire
6	Investigator who shall serve for a term of one (1) year, one member
7	representing a statewide association of electrical workers who shall
8	serve a term of one (1) year, and one member representing a
9	statewide organization of exclusively professional firefighters who
10	shall serve a term of two (2) years. The members of the Commission
11	shall thereafter be appointed for a term of five (5) years and the
12	appointments shall be subject to Senate confirmation; provided the
13	associations named shall be represented by at least one member:
14	1. Four members appointed by the Governor;
15	2. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of
16	Representatives;
17	3. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
18	Senate; and
19	4. The State Fire Marshal.
20	Each member shall serve at the pleasure of his or her appointing
21	authority and may be removed or replaced without cause. Any member
22	of the Commission shall be prohibited from voting on any issue in
23	which the member has an interest.
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SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 324.2, as
 amended by Section 17, Chapter 111, O.S.L. 2013 (74 O.S. Supp. 2018,
 Section 324.2), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 324.2 The State Fire Marshal Commission shall select a 5 chair. The Commission is hereby authorized to adopt rules necessary for the licensure, regulation and enforcement of the fire 6 7 extinguishers pursuant to the Fire Extinguisher Licensing Act and for conducting its proceedings. Any four five members shall 8 9 constitute a quorum. The Commission shall meet monthly on such date 10 as it may designate and may meet at such other times as it may deem 11 necessary, or when called by the chairman or by any four members 12 State Fire Marshal. Complete minutes of each meeting shall be kept 13 and filed in the office of the State Fire Marshal and shall be 14 available for public inspection during reasonable office hours. The 15 Commission shall report annually to the Governor and to the Speaker 16 of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the 17 Senate of the affairs of the Commission and the office of the State 18 Fire Marshal.

19SECTION 3.AMENDATORY74 O.S. 2011, Section 324.4, is20amended to read as follows:

Section 324.4 A. The State Fire Marshal Commission shall
appoint a full-time State Fire Marshal be appointed by the Governor
and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor and may be removed
or replaced without cause. Compensation for the State Fire Marshal

1 shall be determined by the Governor. The State Fire Marshal shall administer and enforce the provisions of law pertaining to the 2 Office of the State Fire Marshal to include, but not be limited to, 3 4 fire and arson investigations, code enforcement, and public education under the supervision of the State Fire Marshal Commission 5 and in accordance with Commission policies. The State Fire Marshal 6 7 shall be a person of good moral character and a resident of Oklahoma at the time of appointment. The State Fire Marshal must have a 8 9 minimum of ten (10) years' experience in fire protection, fire 10 prevention, investigation, or criminal justice, which may include 11 experience with any state, county, municipal, federal, military, or 12 industrial fire protection or criminal justice agency. Successful 13 completion of a degree in fire protection and prevention, criminal 14 justice or administration from an accredited college or university, 15 may be substituted for experience on a year-to-year basis. The 16 State Fire Marshal shall possess administrative ability and 17 experience. The State Fire Marshal may be required to obtain 18 certification as a peace officer in the State of Oklahoma from the 19 Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training, and shall be 20 subject to an extensive background investigation, psychological 21 testing, and drug testing. The Commission may also require 22 additional qualifications. The State Fire Marshal must have or be 23 able to obtain a valid Oklahoma driver license and be a citizen of 24 the United States.

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1 The Commission State Fire Marshal shall appoint a full-time в. 2 Assistant State Fire Marshal upon recommendation from the State Fire The Assistant State Fire Marshal must have a minimum of 3 Marshal. 4 seven (7) years experience in fire protection, fire prevention, 5 investigations or criminal justice, which may include experience with any state, county, municipal, federal, military, or industrial 6 7 fire protection or criminal justice agency. Successful completion of a degree in fire protection and prevention, criminal justice, or 8 9 administration from an accredited college or university, may be 10 substituted for experience on a year-to-year basis. The Assistant 11 State Fire Marshal shall possess administrative ability and 12 experience. The Assistant State Fire Marshal may be required to 13 obtain certification as a peace officer from the Council on Law 14 Enforcement and Education Training, and shall be subject to an 15 extensive background investigation, psychological testing, and drug 16 testing. The Commission may require additional qualifications. The 17 Assistant State Fire Marshal must have or be able to obtain a valid 18 Oklahoma driver license and be a citizen of the United States.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
