- 2. The availability, effectiveness and known contraindications of the influenza immunization;
 - 3. Causes and symptoms of influenza; and
 - 4. The means by which influenza is spread.
 - B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an assisted living center to provide or pay for any immunization against influenza for its residents.
 - C. No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or damage caused by any act or omission resulting from providing, or the lack of providing, educational information pursuant to this act.
 - D. The assisted living center's license shall not be affected nor shall fines be imposed or deficiencies be cited due to the providing, or lack of providing, the educational information pursuant to this section.
