15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 58 O.S. 2011, Section 941, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 941. Presumption of death - Any person missing from his
18	usual place of residence and whose address is unknown by his or her
19	family or those who, in the ordinary course of events, would be
20	expected to know his whereabouts, who is continuously absent and,
21	unheard of for a period of $\frac{\text{seven }(7)}{\text{two }(2)}$ years or longer $\frac{\text{and}}{\text{constant}}$
22	entered into the National Missing and Unidentified Persons System
23	with all identifiers, including dental records, fingerprints and
24	DNA, for a minimum of six (6) months prior to declaration of death,

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    shall be presumed to be dead and the district court, after the
    expiration of such period, shall have jurisdiction and authority to
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    declare such person to be legally dead and to issue letters
    testamentary or letters of administration upon the estates of such
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    persons.
