9 An Act relating to child care; prohibiting entities  
10 certifying child care training from charging for  
11 trainings; providing for acceptance of certain  
12 training; providing for codification; and providing  
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 421 of Title 10, unless there is  
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Any entity contracting with the Department of Human Services to  
19 certify and track training for child care centers, child care  
20 workers, and child care homes licensed by the Department shall not  
21 charge for the trainings that they provide. Training provided by  
22 entities certified for child care training in other states for  
23 individuals working at child care centers or child care homes in  
24 Oklahoma shall be accepted. Training pertaining to child care that

1 is provided by any state institution of higher learning, state  
2 agency, or a state career tech center shall also be accepted by the  
3 contracting entity.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
