15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 4, O.S.L. 2015
16	(70 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 11-103.6j), is amended to read as
17	follows:
18	Section 11-103.6j A. The State Department of Education, in
19	collaboration with the Oklahoma Department of Labor, shall make
20	available to school districts information regarding workplace safety
21	training for grades seven through twelve. Such information shall
22	include the Oklahoma Department of Labor's "Youth @ Work Talking
23	Safety: A Safety and Health Curriculum for Young Workers".

B. The State Department of Education shall encourage school districts to inform grade-seven through -twelve teachers about the importance of incorporating workplace safety training in their curriculum.

- C. A local district board of education shall require a program for seventh grade through twelfth grade teachers, which shall emphasize the importance of incorporating workplace safety training into curriculum. The program shall be completed the first year a certified teacher is employed by a school district, and then once every third academic year.
- $\underline{\text{D.}}$ The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this act.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
