14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-125 of Title 70, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. As used in this section, "instructional expenditure" shall
19	mean expenditures related to the interaction between teachers and
20	students, including salaries and benefits for teachers and teacher
21	aides, textbooks, supplies, and purchased services. These
22	expenditures also include expenditures related to extracurricular
23	and cocurricular activities.

- B. As used in this section, "instruction-related expenditures" shall include expenditures for instruction and instructional staff support services. These are expenditures that are directly related to providing instruction and for activities that assist with classroom instruction, and shall include salaries and benefits for teachers, teaching assistants, librarians, library aides, in-service teacher trainers, curriculum development, student assessments, technology for students, and supplies and purchased services related to those activities.
- C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall apply when related to the expenditure of public funds by school districts. When reporting or publishing the instructional expenditures for any purpose, the State Department of Education shall also report or publish each category of instruction-related expenditure as listed in subsection B of this section as well as the aggregate instructional expenditure.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
