NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 27-104 of Title 70, unless there 19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 20 Α. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Riley's Rule". 21 Prior to the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year, each 22 school district board of education shall coordinate with the 23 emergency medical services provider that serves the area in which

the school district is located to develop a plan for the provision

of emergency medical services at football and high-impact sporting events or activities held at school district facilities. C. The plan developed pursuant to subsection B of this section shall be reviewed and updated annually as appropriate and placed on file with the school district and the emergency medical services provider. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and

be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
