8 An Act relating to criminal procedure; authorizing  
9 peace officers to stop and detain persons under  
10 certain circumstances; requiring detained person to  
11 provide certain information; authorizing further  
12 detention if necessary; providing for the release or  
13 arrest of detained person; providing for  
14 codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 212 of Title 22, unless there is  
18 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A peace officer may stop any person who the peace officer  
20 reasonably suspects is committing, has committed or is about to  
21 commit a violation of the criminal laws of this state or the  
22 criminal ordinances of a municipality and may require the person to  
23 give his or her name and address and photo identification, if  
24 available. Any person who fails to identify himself or herself and  
explain his or her actions to the satisfaction of the peace officer

1 may be further detained and further questioned and investigated by  
2 the peace officer. At the end of the detention period, the person  
3 so detained shall be released unless arrested and charged with a  
4 crime.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
