COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to elections; requiring institutions of higher education to establish location for notarization and mailing of absentee ballots; requiring institution to provide certain items; providing for informing of students and staff of certain information; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-115.7 of Title 26, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

All institutions of higher education shall establish a central location for the notarization and mailing of absentee ballots. The institutions shall provide a notary, stamps available for purchase and an official mailbox for the deposit of United States mail. In addition, the institutions shall inform the students and staff of the information contained in this section, including how to obtain

1 an absentee ballot, at least two (2) weeks prior to all statewide
2 elections.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
