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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-527, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 1-527. <u>A.</u> Any physician who makes a diagnosis or
19	treats a case of a sexually transmitted infection (STI), and every
20	superintendent or manager of a hospital, dispensary or charitable or
21	penal institution in which there is a case of an STI, shall report
22	such case immediately, in writing , to or electronically:
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1	1. To the director or designee of the city-county health
2	department, if in Oklahoma County or Tulsa County, who shall, in
3	turn, report such case to the State Commissioner of Health; or
4	2. Directly to the State Commissioner of Health, or the local
5	health officer if not in Oklahoma County or Tulsa County,
6	in the same manner as other communicable diseases are reported, in
7	forms to be prescribed and furnished by the Commissioner.
8	B. This act shall remain in effect until such time as the
9	Oklahoma State Department of Health has in place a disease reporting
10	process that provides for a direct report from a lab or physician's
11	office to the local health department and is capable of connecting a
12	lab or physician's office with local health department systems for
13	timely data delivery and start of the disease investigation process.
14	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
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
