20	Abuse Services shall approve a standard medication fee for persons
21	participating in an opioid substitution treatment program who are
22	recipients of Medicaid. An opioid substitution treatment program

A person participating in an opioid substitution treatment В. program shall be terminated from the program if the person fails to participate in counseling sessions or if the person fails to adhere to the program's guidelines as promulgated by the Board.
