COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to narcotic treatment programs;  
amending 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-603, which relates  
to medication fee for participation in opioid  
substitution treatment program; transferring  
authority to assess medication fee on certain persons  
to opioid substitution treatment program; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-603, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 3-603. A. The Board of Mental Health and Substance  
Abuse Services shall approve a standard medication fee for persons  
participating in an opioid substitution treatment program who are  
recipients of Medicaid. An opioid substitution treatment program  
may assess a medication fee on persons participating in the opioid

1 substitution treatment program who are not recipients of Medicaid in  
2 an amount determined by the opioid substitution treatment program.

3 B. A person participating in an opioid substitution treatment  
4 program shall be terminated from the program if the person fails to  
5 participate in counseling sessions or if the person fails to adhere  
6 to the program's guidelines as promulgated by the Board.

7 C. The Board is authorized to promulgate such rules as are  
8 necessary to implement this act.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
