1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless 2 3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The bridge over Coal Creek located on US Highway 75 Business 4 5 within the municipal limits of Henryetta shall be designated as the "Edward A. DeVore, Jr., Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient, 6 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause 7 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the 8 9 bridge.

10 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless 12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: The portion of State Highway 56 beginning just west of North 13 Wood Drive and extending approximately one (1) mile west through the 14 municipal limits of Okmulgee shall be designated as the "CPL Russell 15 Keck, Navy Star Recipient, Memorial Highway". The Department of 16 17 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway. 18
