8	An Act relating to roads and bridges; enacting the Oklahoma First Act; amending 69 O.S. 2011, Section
9	1101, which relates to letting contracts; providing for certain preference for certain contract awarding
10	procedure; updating statutory language; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
16	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma First
17	Act".
18	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1101, is
19	amended to read as follows:
20	Section 1101. A. All contracts for construction work upon the
21	state or county highway system shall be let and awarded pursuant to
22	the provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 <u>;</u>
23	provided that in awarding a transportation project adjusted score
24	design-build contract, greater value is assigned to a proposal in

1 proportion to the extent the proposal commits to using Oklahoma-2 owned businesses to perform work on the transportation project. 3 However, the preference is suspended to the extent necessary to 4 prevent denial of federal monies or to eliminate inconsistency with 5 federal law resulting from application of the preference. If the project advertised pursuant to the provisions of the Public 6 Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 is for the construction of more than 7 eight (8) miles of road, and is not a surface treatment only 8 9 project, said the advertisement shall provide for bids on sections 10 of the road no longer than eight (8) miles, as well as bids on the 11 project as a whole. If the project advertised pursuant to the provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974 is a 12 surface treatment only project of more than twenty (20) miles of 13 road, the advertisement shall provide for bids on sections of the 14 road no longer than twenty (20) miles, as well as bids on the 15 project as a whole. 16

B. The Department may extend a contract no more than twentyfive percent (25%) of the length and extent of the original project.
The price for the extension work shall not be greater than the
contract unit basis.

21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
