COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to health insurance; requiring insurer payment or reimbursement to pharmacist in certain circumstances; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3436.6 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

An insurer, as defined in Section 3634.2 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall provide payment or reimbursement to a pharmacist for providing a health care service to an individual if:

1. The pharmacist provided any of the following health care services pursuant to Section 353.30 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

- a. the management of drug therapy, or
- b. the administration of immunizations, or
- c. the administration of therapeutic injections; or

1 2. The health benefit policy, contract or agreement of the
2 individual provides for payment or reimbursement of the service.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.

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
