NEW LAW 20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1017.6 of Title 56, unless there 21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 22 As used in this section, "Program of All-Inclusive Care for 23 the Elderly (PACE) " means a full risk-bearing program that provides 24 comprehensive health services for individuals age fifty-five (55)

and over who are sufficiently frail to be categorized as nursing 1 home eligible by the state's Medicaid program. PACE shall be reimbursed on a fixed per-member per-month rate and, in return for such fixed payment, is responsible for providing all health services, including transportation.

Persons who are fifty-five (55) years of age or older, or their legal quardians or lay careqivers, shall receive options counseling for long-term care as defined in Section 3002.7 of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes prior to admission to a long-term care facility, except in the case of an emergency admission. counseling shall include, but not be limited to, PACE, if so applicable, nursing facilities and home- and community-based services.
- 2. In the case of an emergency admission, the options counseling for long-term care shall take place within fourteen (14) days of the emergency admission or as soon as is reasonably possible.
- 3. Persons who are fifty-five (55) years of age or older and live within the defined service area of a PACE provider shall receive information regarding PACE as part of options counseling for long-term care as defined in Section 3002.7 of Title 56 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- 4. Any person currently residing in a nursing facility shall be able to receive options counseling for long-term care as defined in
