13	SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, the

9 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 10 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 11 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (hereafter FY-20) or may be 12 13 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21). Funds budgeted for FY-20 may be encumbered only through June 30, 14 2020, and must be expended by November 15, 2020. Any funds 15 remaining after November 15, 2020, and not budgeted for FY-21, shall 16 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 17 year. Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 18 30, 2021. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2021, shall lapse 19 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 20 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years 21 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-20, and not required to pay 22 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-21, after 23 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared 24
