There is hereby created the Office of Mobility 15 16 and Public Transit within the Department of Transportation. current Transit Division responsibilities, including oversight and 17 management of Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grants and 18 resources and the State Management Plan, are moved to the Office of 19 Mobility and Public Transit. Notwithstanding this subsection, the 20 Office of Mobility and Public Transit will not be responsible for 21 oversight and management of FTA grants and resources received by 22 transit agencies as a direct recipient of the FTA as that is not a 23 current responsibility of the Transit Division. All Federal Transit 24
