| 13 | SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified |
| 14 | in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 510.3 of Title 70, unless there |
| 15 | is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: |
| 16 | A. As used in this section, "military-connected student" means |
| 17 | a student enrolled in a school district or charter school |
| 18 | established pursuant to Section 3-132 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma |
| 19 | Statutes who: |
| 20 | 1. Is a dependent of a current or former member of the United |
| 21 | States military, the Oklahoma National Guard or a reserve force of |

- 2. Was a dependent of a member of the United States military, the Oklahoma National Guard or a reserve force of the United States military who was killed in the line of duty.
- B. Beginning with the 2021-2022 school year, the State

 Department of Education shall designate a school district site or

 charter school site as a Purple Star School if the site applies and

 qualifies for the designation pursuant to this section.
- C. To qualify as a Purple Star School, a school district site or charter school site shall:
- 1. Designate a school employee as a military liaison whose duties include:
 - a. identifying military-connected students enrolled at the school who are designated with a military student identifier as provided for in Section 3-168 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
 - b. serving as the point of contact between the school and military-connected students and their families,
 - c. determining appropriate school services available to military-connected students, and
 - d. assisting in coordinating school programs relevant to military-connected students;
- 2. Maintain on the school's website an easily accessible web page that includes resources for military-connected students and their families including information regarding:

1 relocation to, enrollment at, registration at and transferring records to the school, 2 3 b. academic planning, course sequences and advanced classes available at the school, 4 5 C. counseling and other support services available for military-connected students enrolled at the campus, 6 and 7 d. the military liaison and his or her duties designated 8 9 pursuant to paragraph 1 of this subsection; 10 3. Maintain a transition program led by students, where 11 appropriate, that assists military-connected students in transitioning into the school; 12 13 4. Offer professional development for school employees on issues related to military-connected students; and 14 5. Offer at least one of the following initiatives: 15 a resolution showing support for military-connected 16 a. students and their families, 17 recognition of the Month of the Military Child or 18 b. Military Family Month with relevant events held at the 19 school site, or 20 a partnership with a local military installation that 21 C. provides opportunities for active duty military 22

members to volunteer at the school site, speak at an

assembly or host a field trip.
