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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-311.1 of Title 63, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. A drug wholesaler is prohibited from preventing a licensed  
16 pharmacy under contract with the wholesaler from purchasing drugs  
17 that the wholesaler sells if the pharmacy is in compliance with all  
18 applicable state and federal laws.

19 B. As used in this section, "drug wholesaler" means any person  
20 within this state, other than a manufacturer, who sells, transfers,  
21 or in any manner furnishes a drug product to any other person in  
22 this state for the purpose of being resold.  
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1 C. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and  
2 Dangerous Drugs Control shall promulgate rules to implement the  
3 provisions of this section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
