7 [public health and safety - diabetes prevention -
8 report - effective date]
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10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 46, O.S.L. 2015
12 (63 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 7301), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 7301. A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority and the
14 State Department of Health shall collaborate to identify benchmarks
15 and develop goals to reduce the incidence rates of, improve health
16 care services for, and control complications resulting from
17 diabetes.

18 B. The Authority and the Department shall submit a report to
19 the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House
20 of Representatives by January ~~10th~~ 10 of ~~odd-numbered years~~ every
21 fifth year, beginning January 10, 2021. Such report shall contain
22 the following information:

23 1. The fiscal impact of all types of diabetes on the Authority,
24 the Department, ~~and~~ county health departments and the state

1 including the number of persons with diabetes receiving services
2 through the Authority, the Department, and county health
3 departments;

4 2. The fiscal impact of diabetes on the Authority, the
5 Department, and county health departments in comparison to other
6 chronic diseases;

7 3. An assessment of the benefits of diabetes prevention
8 programs including a summary of funding directed to the Authority
9 and the Department from the Oklahoma State Legislature;

10 4. A description of coordination between the Authority ~~and~~, the
11 Department and the healthcare sector including, but not limited to,
12 programs relating to the treatment and prevention of all forms of
13 diabetes;

14 5. Detailed action plans for battling diabetes with actionable
15 items for consideration by the Legislature including, but not
16 limited to, steps to reduce the impact of diabetes, pre-diabetes,
17 and related diabetes complications;

18 6. Identification of expected outcomes of the action steps and
19 benchmarks for controlling and preventing all forms of diabetes; and

20 7. The development of a detailed budget blueprint identifying
21 needs, costs, and resources required to implement the plan provided
22 for in this act. Such blueprint shall include a budget range for
23 all options presented in the plan for consideration by the
24 Legislature.

1 C. The provisions of this ~~act~~ section shall be limited to
2 diabetes information, data, initiatives, and programs within the
3 Authority and the Department prior to ~~the effective date of this act~~
4 November 1, 2015, unless there is available funding for diabetes in
5 each agency that may be used for new research, data collection
6 reporting or other requirements of this ~~act~~ section.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
