AMENDATORY 12 amended to read as follows: Section 1-515. Every physician attending a pregnant woman in 13 Oklahoma during gestation shall, in the case of each woman so 14 15 attended, take or cause to be taken a sample of blood of such woman at the time of first examination, and submit such sample to an 16 approved laboratory for a standard serological test for syphilis and 17 human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), unless the woman explicitly 18 declines. Every other person permitted by law to attend upon 19 pregnant women in the state but not permitted by law to take blood 20 tests shall cause a sample of the blood of such pregnant woman to be 21 taken by a duly licensed physician, licensed to practice in the 22 State of Oklahoma this state, and submitted to an approved 23 laboratory for a standard serological test for syphilis and HIV, 24

1	unless the woman explicitly declines. The term "approved
2	laboratory" shall mean a laboratory approved for the purposes of
3	this section by the State Commissioner of Health. A standard
4	serological test for syphilis <u>and HIV</u> shall be one recognized as
5	such by the Commissioner. Such laboratory tests shall be made, on
6	request, without charge by the State Department of Health.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
