10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-120, is  
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 4-120. The registration of any registered voter ~~may~~  
14 shall be cancelled ~~only~~ for ~~one~~ any of the following reasons:

15 1. Written notice from the voter; ~~death~~

16 2. Death of the voter; ~~conviction~~

17 3. Conviction of or plea of guilty or nolo contendere to a  
18 felony offense by the voter; ~~judicial~~

19 4. Judicial determination of mental incapacitation of the voter  
20 under Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes; ~~registration~~

21 5. Registration by the voter in another county or state; ~~or~~  
22 failure

23 6. Failure by the voter to respond to a confirmation of address  
24 mailing and subsequent failure to vote or initiate a change in voter

1 registration as prescribed in Section ~~21~~ 4-120.2 of this act title;  
2 or

3 7. The voter is identified as deceased or as having moved out  
4 of state by a multistate voter list maintenance organization of  
5 which this state is a member pursuant to Section 2 of this act. For  
6 the purposes of this paragraph, written notice shall be sent to the  
7 voter at the mailing address on file at the county election board  
8 prior to the cancellation of a voter registration. The voter shall  
9 have thirty (30) days from the date the notice is sent to provide  
10 the appropriate county election board with evidence contrary to the  
11 findings of the multistate voter list maintenance organization.

12 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-121 of Title 26, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. The Secretary of the State Election Board may join the State  
16 of Oklahoma as a member in one or more multistate voter list  
17 maintenance organizations including, but not limited to, the  
18 Electronic Registration Information Center (ERIC) or its successor.  
19 The Secretary is authorized to expend funds as available for  
20 membership fees, dues and other expenses related to such membership.

21 B. Upon membership in an organization as provided in subsection  
22 A of this section, the Secretary of the State Election Board may  
23 provide voter registration data to the organization and the  
24 Department of Public Safety may provide motor vehicle license data

1 to the organization if such data is required to be provided as a  
2 condition of membership. The voter registration data and motor  
3 vehicle license data described in this subsection may include a  
4 person's name, address, date of birth, driver license or state  
5 identification number, last four digits of a social security number  
6 or any other data required by the organization. The transmission  
7 and storage of such data shall be done in a secure manner.

8 C. If a multistate voter list maintenance organization of which  
9 this state is a member identifies Oklahoma residents who are  
10 citizens of the United States eligible to vote but not yet  
11 registered, the Secretary of the State Election Board may notify  
12 such citizens about the procedure for becoming a registered voter in  
13 this state. The Secretary may delegate the contacting of such  
14 citizens to the secretary of the appropriate county election board.

15 D. If a multistate voter list maintenance organization of which  
16 this state is a member identifies a registered voter who has changed  
17 his or her address of residence within the state, the Secretary of  
18 the State Election Board may contact such voter and advise him or  
19 her of the requirement to be registered at the address of residence  
20 of the voter. The voter shall be provided such information as may  
21 be necessary for the voter to change his or her voter registration  
22 to a new address of residence. The Secretary may delegate the  
23 contacting of such citizens to the secretary of the appropriate  
24 county election board.
