7 An Act relating to Firefighters Pension and
8 Retirement System; amending 11 O.S. 2011, Section 49-
111, as amended by Section 8, Chapter 364, O.S.L.
2012 (11 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 49-111), which
9 relates to temporary sickness or disability;
10 correcting improper statutory title reference due to
repeal of Title 85; and updating statutory language.

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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 49-111, as
15 amended by Section 8, Chapter 364, O.S.L. 2012 (11 O.S. Supp. 2019,
16 Section 49-111), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 49-111. A. Whenever any member of the fire department
18 of any municipality, on account of sickness or temporary disability,
19 other than a burn injury, caused or sustained while in the discharge
20 of the member's duty as such member, is unable to perform the
21 member's duties, notwithstanding the workers' compensation
22 provisions of Title ~~85~~ 85A of the Oklahoma Statutes related to
23 temporary disability benefits, the salary shall be paid by the
24 municipality to the member and shall continue while the member is

1 sick or temporarily disabled for a period of not more than six (6)
2 months with the municipality having the option of extending the
3 period for up to an additional six (6) months, not to exceed a total
4 of twelve (12) months, after which period the provisions for
5 disability benefits under the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and
6 Retirement System shall apply. The salary received by the member
7 under this subsection while the member is sick or temporarily
8 disabled for a period specified in this subsection shall be, or
9 deemed to be, part of the member's actual paid gross salary under
10 the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and Retirement System.
11 Contributions shall be made on actual paid gross salary paid
12 pursuant to this section.

13 B. Whenever any member of the fire department of any
14 municipality, on account of a burn injury, caused or sustained while
15 in the discharge of the member's duty as such member, is unable to
16 perform the member's duties, notwithstanding the workers'
17 compensation provisions of Title ~~85~~ 85A of the Oklahoma Statutes
18 related to temporary disability benefits, the salary shall be paid
19 by the municipality to the member and shall continue while the
20 member is sick or temporarily disabled for a period of not more than
21 twelve (12) months with the municipality having the option of
22 extending the period for up to an additional six (6) months, not to
23 exceed a total of eighteen (18) months, after which ~~said~~ the period
24 the provisions for disability benefits under the Oklahoma

1 Firefighters Pension and Retirement System shall apply. The salary
2 received by the member under this subsection while the member is
3 sick or temporarily disabled for a period specified in this
4 subsection shall be, or deemed to be, part of the member's actual
5 paid gross salary under the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and
6 Retirement System. Contributions shall be made on actual paid gross
7 salary paid pursuant to this section.

8 C. Should a member receiving a salary under this section be
9 eligible to receive, and should the salary of the member under this
10 section exceed any temporary disability benefit paid to the member
11 under the workers' compensation provisions of Title ~~85~~ 85A of the
12 Oklahoma Statutes, the member shall transfer such temporary
13 disability benefits under the workers' compensation provisions of
14 Title ~~85~~ 85A of the Oklahoma Statutes to the municipality while the
15 member is sick or temporarily disabled.
