8 An Act relating to memorial highway and bridge
9 designations; designating the Trooper J.C. Magar
10 Memorial Highway; designating the Edward A. DeVore,
11 Jr., Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient, Memorial
12 Bridge; designating the CPL Russell Keck, Navy Star
13 Recipient, Memorial Highway; designating the Tommy
14 Wayne Hailey Memorial Bridge; designating the Michael
15 W. Johnson, P.E. Memorial Bridge; designating the
16 Medal of Honor Recipient Sergeant John R. Crews
17 Memorial Bridge; designating the OHP Captain Larry
18 Jackson Memorial Highway; designating the President
19 Donald J. Trump Highway; designating the James Amos
20 Callins Memorial Bridge; designating the Bud Martin
21 Memorial Bridge; designating the William Charles
22 "Charley" Coen Memorial Highway; designating the SSGT
23 Cecil Wellman Memorial Bridge; designating the
24 Lieutenant Eugene Smith Memorial Highway; requiring
certain markers; providing for codification;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The portion of State Highway 271 beginning south of the
2 municipal limits of Hugo and ending north of the municipal limits of
3 Grant shall be designated as the "Trooper J.C. Magar Memorial
4 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
5 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The bridge over Coal Creek located on US Highway 75 Business
10 within the municipal limits of Henryetta shall be designated as the
11 "Edward A. DeVore, Jr., Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient,
12 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
13 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
14 bridge.

15 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The portion of State Highway 56 beginning just west of North
19 Wood Drive and extending approximately one (1) mile west through the
20 municipal limits of Okmulgee shall be designated as the "CPL Russell
21 Keck, Navy Cross Recipient, Memorial Highway". The Department of
22 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
23 name to be placed on the highway.

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1 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.311 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over Chouteau Creek on U.S. Highway 77 approximately
5 2 miles north of Lexington in Cleveland County shall be designated
6 as the "Tommy Wayne Hailey Memorial Bridge". The Department of
7 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
8 name to be placed on the highway.

9 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.312 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge on
13 Interstate 35 crossing over State Highway 33 in Logan County shall
14 be designated as the "Michael W. Johnson, P.E. Memorial Bridge".
15 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
16 markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

17 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.313 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The bridge over Western Avenue on Interstate 240 within the
21 municipal limits of Oklahoma City shall be designated as the "Medal
22 of Honor Recipient Sergeant John R. Crews Memorial Bridge". The
23 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
24 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

1 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.314 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The portion of U.S. Highway 75 beginning at the intersection of
5 East 116th St. and ending at the intersection of East 126th St.
6 within the municipal limits of Tulsa shall be designated as the "OHP
7 Captain Larry Jackson Memorial Highway". The Department of
8 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
9 name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.315 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
14 Highway 287 beginning at the municipal limits of Boise City and
15 extending southeast to the Oklahoma-Texas border in Cimarron County
16 shall be designated as the "President Donald J. Trump Highway". The
17 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
18 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.316 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge over the Salt Fork of the Red River on State Highway
23 34 south of the municipal limits of Mangum shall be designated as
24 the "James Amos Callins Memorial Bridge". The Department of

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
2 name to be placed on the bridge.

3 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.317 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The bridge over Turkey Creek approximately three miles east of
7 the municipal limits of Fargo in Woodward County shall be designated
8 as the "Bud Martin Memorial Bridge". The Department of
9 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
10 name to be placed on the bridge.

11 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.318 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The portion of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the intersection of
15 U.S. Highway 283 and extending southeast to the municipal limits of
16 Rosston shall be designated as the "William Charles "Charley" Coen
17 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
18 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
19 highway.

20 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.319 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge over Interstate 35 on State Highway 74 within the
24 municipal limits of Purcell in McClain County shall be designated as

1 the "SSGT Cecil Wellman Memorial Bridge". The Department of
2 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
3 name to be placed on the bridge.

4 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.320 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The portion of State Highway 51B beginning one half mile west of
8 the western municipal limits of Porter and ending one half mile east
9 of the eastern municipal limits of Porter shall be designated as the
10 "Lieutenant Eugene Smith Memorial Highway". The Department of
11 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
12 name to be placed on the highway.

13 SECTION 14. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

14 SECTION 15. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take
17 effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
