15	Section 1948. All licensed behavioral practitioners licensed
16	pursuant to the Licensed Behavioral Practitioner Act shall be
17	required to satisfactorily complete ten (10) hours of continuing
18	education credits annually. The State Board of Behavioral Health
19	Licensure shall provide forms and require verification of such
20	credits. Such credits shall be earned from courses on empirically
21	validated procedures, taught by instructors certified by the North
22	American Association of Masters in Psychology, its designees or
23	successors.
